- Phase 1: Opportunities for improvement included: 1) Communicating with students that COM is trying to implement what they are asking for. 2) Recommended action plans- a) make more assessment items step 1 style b) add more step1 practice questions for each classroom activity c) use the usmle content outline as a guide to phase 1 curriculum d) trying to find a mechanism to hold departmental chairs accountable for quality of classroom educational activities 3) integration and reinforcement of knowledge, flash backs and flash forwards used more frequently 4) Would be helpful to have a "You Said, We Did" for the whole year.
- Phase 2: 1) Utility of the med ed programs 2) objectives to support learning 3) Adequacy of health education and maintenance 4) Assessment and system feedback 5) Non-standardized grading process was an issue 6) Need for more fair and useful objective assessment tools 7) adequacy of education to manage disease. 8) Classes of 25 and 26 have not seen enough patients yet 9) Need to add more objective methods for grading assignments. This includes getting all faculty on same page.10) Incorporate EKG practice
